


PRATIBHA SHAKTI, NAGPUR



Shakti Shodh Setu (SSS) is a project for mentoring girl students of disadvantaged section of the society in their academic project work in different fields of Science and Technology. Women Scientists / Academicians from National Scientific Organisations / Institutions were identified as Mentors. The uniquesness of SSS is the mentoring and handholding continues till the mentee finds a foothold in her career. It was launched on 20th April 2024 by the National President, Shakti, Dr Sudha Tiwari in an online mode, where the unit coordinators, mentors and mentees participated. Selection process of Mentees from different units was by scrutinizing the project proposal, followed by oral interaction on a virtual platform by an expert committee. A total of 11 students are assigned to 9 Mentors based on their project proposals. More mentees are being solicited to link up with other eminent Mentors which is expected to commence in this academic year

of millets, their cultivation, their nutritive value and methods to consume millets with the help of photos.


